Follow these steps when filing an insurance claim:

- 1. Hire an expert roofing company that is certified to inspect and document the damage immediately following a severe weather event (such as wind, hail, or heavy rain).
- 2. Given the inspection findings, review your insurance policy with your roofing contractor to determine if filing an insurance claim makes sense.
- 3. Obtain an estimate from your roofing contractor. Do not rely on the insurance adjuster to accurately determine the repair or replacement cost of your roof.
- 4. File your insurance claim and notify your insurance company that you retained a roofing contractor to advocate on your behalf.
- 5. Prepare to meet with the insurance adjuster by having your roofing contractor present at the inspection performed by the insurance adjuster.

- 6. Assuming your insurance company approves a roof repair or replacement, promptly collaborate with your roofing contractor to schedule the work.
- 7. As your roofing contractor completes each stage of the roof repair or replacement project, communicate with your insurance company.
- 8. Ensure all required inspections pass to the satisfaction of local ordinances and the insurance company.
- 9. Collect all insurance funds disbursed from your insurance company and settle all amounts owed to your roofing contractor.
- 10. Secure and register any manufacturer or workmanship warranties associated with the new roofing materials installed on your home.
